**ORDER**

**WHEREAS** the appeal of Lord Krishna College of Education, Hissar, Haryana dated 22/06/2009 is against the Order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F73/HR-1731/2009 dated 23/04/2009 of the Northern Regional Committee, refusing recognition for conducting B.Ed course on the grounds "1) CLU is not issued by the competent authority on the prescribed format. 2) In response to our letter, the State Government recommendation is negative".

**AND WHEREAS** the appellants case was heard on 25-7-09 and the case was rejected vide Appellate Order dated 07-08-09. Aggrieved by this order, the appellant filed a writ petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.

**AND WHEREAS** the Council noted that the Hon'ble High Court in their Order dated 26-08-09 set aside the Council's Order dated 07-08-09 and remanded the matter to the Council for consideration afresh in terms of the submissions recorded in this order. The Council has to consider and pass an order within 10 days from 26-08-09.

**AND WHEREAS** the Council, as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court, has reconsidered the matter on 4-9-09. After taking all aspects of the matter into consideration and in particular the certificate of Gram Panchayat that was available with NRC read with the letter of the District Town Planner Enforcement, Hissar No.549 dated 06-04-09 addressed to the President, Adarsh Education Society, VPO, Siwani Bolan, Hissar and other precedents mentioned in the Hon'ble High court Order, the Council has come to the conclusion that, in supersession of the Council's order dated 07-08-09, the case of the institution deserves to be remanded to the NRC for conducting an inspection and taking an appropriate decision thereafter.

**AND WHEREAS** after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Committee reached the conclusion that there was enough ground to accept the appeal, set aside NRC's order dated 28-05-09 and remand back the case to NRC with the direction that the institution should be inspected to ascertain availability of necessary infrastructure, instructional and other facilities in accordance with the norms prescribed by the NCTE to become eligible for

recognition by NCTE. Accordingly, the Council remanded back the case to the NRC for inspection of the Institution immediately and thereafter, to issue order.

**NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby remands back the case of Lord Krishna College of Education, VPO-Siwani Bolan , Hisar - , Haryana to the NRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above.**
