ORDER

WHEREAS the appeal of Shri Ganesh College of Education, Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan dated 13/07/2009 is against the Order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-3/RJ-1082/2009 - dated 17.07.09 of the Northern Regional Committee, withdrawing recognition for conducting B.Ed course on the grounds "The deficiency communicated to the institution still exists in the letter issued dated 11.05.09 i.e. 1) Library facility is not as per NCTE norms including journals and encyclopedia. 2) Sitting place in the library. 3) Multipurpose hall is too small. 4) Total Builtup area for all courses is only 22000 sq.ft. which is not as per NCTE norms. 5) The teaching faculty is not appointed as per NCTE norms. 6) Internet facility is not available. 7) The salary is not being paid through bank. 8) Proper accounts have not been maintained in respect of money charged for uniform from the students in addition to the prescribed fee. 9) Students are marked absent delibratory and imposed fine. 10) EPF is not being maintained".

AND WHEREAS the Correspondent, Shri Ganesh College of Education (hereinafter referred to as the appellatant), preferred an appeal dated 13/07/2009 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.

AND WHEREAS Shri. Suresh Kumar, President and Shri. Sushil Kumar, Secretary, Shri Ganesh College of Education, Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan presented the case of the appellatant institution on 20.08.09. In the appeal and during personal presentation it was submitted that Library facilities were as per NCTE Norms, with adequate seating space; Total available built up area was 47,236 sq ft (Including Class Room, Lab, Library, Reception, Adm Block, Multipurpose Hall) for the B.Ed college & this area was meant for conducting Education Courses, and whereas the inspection team calculated only the class rooms built up area; Teaching faculty was as per NCTE Norms & Salary to the staff was paid through the Bank; Classes were held as per NCTE Norms with proper Attendance.

AND WHEREAS the Council noted from the VTR dated 29.03.09 that the appellatant had been conducting B.Ed course (one unit) and STC course (two units) and also Shiksha Shastri Course (one unit) and for all these courses the available built up area was approximately 22,000 sq. ft. only and this was not adequate as per norms for conducting multiple courses. It also noted from the documents submitted to NRC on 12.06.09, in response to the show cause notice dated 11.05.09, that second floor of the building and also multipurpose hall were under construction and to this effect an affidavit dated 11.06.09 was submitted stating that the construction would be completed by 30.06.09. It further noted that building completion certificate indicating the availability of 47236 sq. ft. of built up area was issued by an architect on 06.08.09 and not by a competent civic authority. From the building plan and building completion certificate it was evident that the appellatant was not in possession of 47236 sq. ft. of built up area at the time of inspection. It also observed

that salary to the staff was paid through the bank, only with effect from May, 2009. In view of the above the Council came to the conclusion that there was no justification in accepting the appeal and that it should be rejected.

AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT Report and after hearing oral arguments advanced during hearing, the Council reached the conclusion that there was no ground to accept the appeal and that it should be rejected. Accordingly, the appeal was rejected and NRC's order dated 17.07.09 was confirmed.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby confirms the Order appealed against.
