## PUBLIC NOTICE

The National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), established under the NCTE Act, 1993, with a view to achieve planned and coordinated development of teacher education system and in order to regulate the growth of teacher education at all levels, has decided, inter-alia in consultation with the State Govts/UTs, not to further recognize/permit institutions for conduct of following teacher training course(s); for the academic session 2010-2011 in the States indicated below:-

2. The above restrictions will however not apply in case of Minority Educational Institutions established under Article 30 of the Constitution.

3. This step is being taken by NCTE as a temporary measure for regulating the growth of teacher training institutions, pending State-wise assessment of the manpower requirement of trained teachers in the country.

4. From rest of the States and UTs, the applications in the prescribed form can be submitted from **1st September, 2009 to 31st October, 2009**, to the concerned Regional Committees, along with necessary fee and documents as specified in the NCTE Regulations, as applicable on 1st September, 2009. Applications can also be submitted **online** and payment can be made through core banking at any branch of State Bank of India or ICICI bank in the country, as per details available on the NCTE website.
